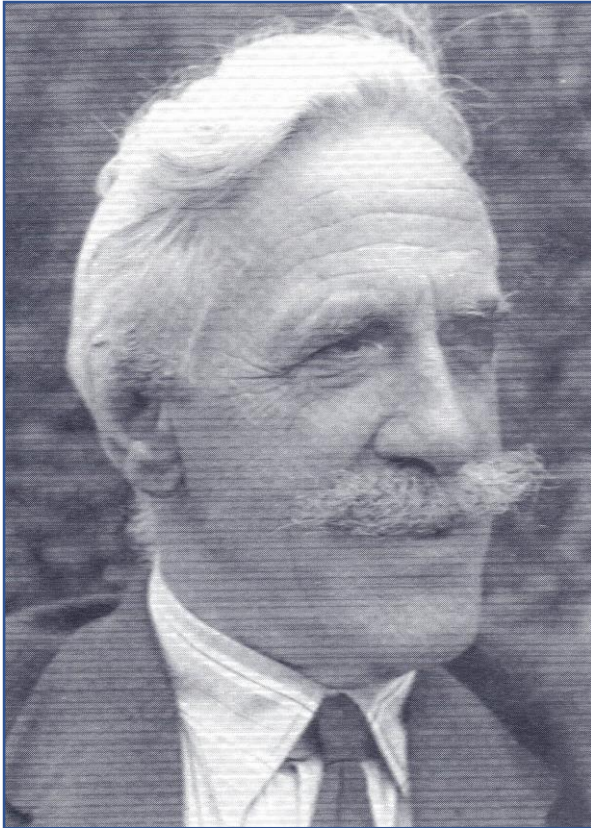




Biographical and Other Notes

Taffs was a clerical officer at the War Office and Royal Almonry. He was a founder member of the BNS in 1903 and editor of the first twenty-one volumes of the BNJ. During the second world war he spent much time sorting the coins that had been donated to the Red Cross for sale. His extensive collection of British, Colonial and Foreign Coins, including tokens, especially 17th C, was sold in 927 lots at Glendinings on 21-23 November 1956.
