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## Biographical and Other Notes

Born S.M. Draycott, in Sheffield. Lifelong involvement with the National Union of Students, Education activist and Government Advisor. Wife of P.D. Greenall (1915-1991). Mostly worked and published on 17<sup>th</sup> C tokens. Important work on the date and geographical distributions of 17<sup>th</sup> C tokens and on London locations. Articles in TCSB, SNC and BNJ.

The combined Greenall collections of English Tradesmen's tokens 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> C etc. sold at Baldwins in 417 lots 30 October 1997. Specialized collection of 870 Venetian coins and medals were donated to the BM.
