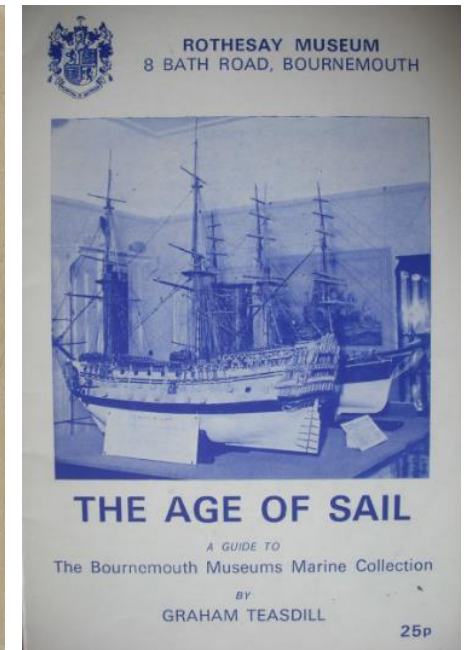
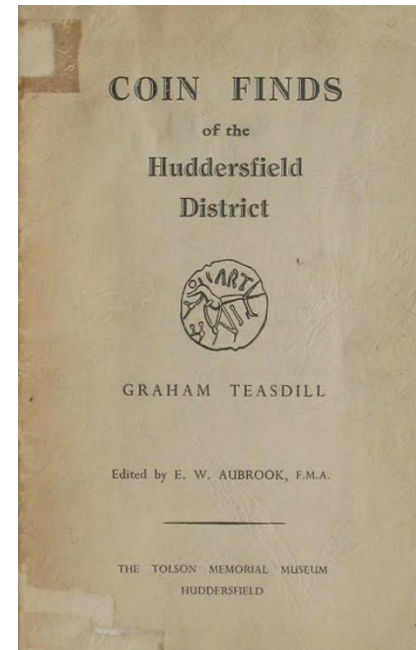

Biographical and Other Notes

Born at Horsforth near Leeds and after a short time in Wales (learning Welsh), returned to Yorkshire after the war and Ilkley Grammar School. During the summer holidays he catalogued the Leeds City Museum coin collection. He decided to become a Museum Curator at the age of 10, and his first job was assistant curator at the Tolson Museum in Huddersfield. Several posts later he became curator of the Russell Coates Art Gallery and Museum in Bournemouth in 1966. An active member of local numismatic and other societies through his life, he took early retirement for health reasons in 1988. He spent 20 years in various position in the Wessex Numismatic Society.
